Indicators of Autism Spectrum Disorder

- Lack of development or delayed development of speech
- Lack of or infrequent initiation of social interaction
- Lack of gestures such as pointing, head shaking, or nodding
- Lack of understanding of social cues
- Inability to engage in simple social games such as peek-a-boo
- Avoids eye contact
- Prefers to be alone or plays parallel to other children
- Lack of pretend or symbolic play
- Deficit in the development of shared attention
- Uses toys in odd ways such as spinning or lining up
- Repetitive body movements such as rocking, pacing, or hand flapping
- Resists changes in routine
- Over- and under-sensitivity to sound, smell, touch, or visual stimulus.

The Children's Developmental Center and Sageview Youth Psychology have developed a multidisciplinary diagnostic team which evaluates children suspected of having an autism spectrum disorder.

TEAM Members

Lead by Scott Grewe, Ph.D., ABPP/CN, the team also includes:

- Licensed Speech/Language Pathologist
- Licensed Physical Therapist
- Early Intervention Specialist/Autism Specialist

Areas of Evaluation

CADET evaluations assess general cognitive ability, communication, gross and fine motor, adaptive skills, social communication, sensory functioning, behavioral adjustment, and parent-child interactions.



Referrals

CADET evaluates children between 18 months and 8 years of age. A referral by a primary care physician is required.

Initial Consultation

Dr. Scott Grewe completes an initial interview with the child and their family to clarify concerns and determine if a formal evaluation is warranted.

Evaluation

CADET evaluations are conducted at the Children's Developmental Center and can take up to 4 hours.

Following the evaluation, the family meets with various team members to discuss results, diagnostic impressions, and any recommendations. A comprehensive report including evaluation results, recommendations, and resources is sent to the child's family and referring physician.

Cost

This program is provided in partnership. Payment for the initial consultation is made to Sageview Youth Psychology and payment for the evaluation is made to Children's Developmental Center.

Families are responsible for deductibles, co-pays, and coinsurance payments. Payment plans are available.
