Indicators of Autism Spectrum Disorder

- Lack of development or delayed development of speech
- Lack of or infrequent initiation of social interaction
- Lack of gestures such as pointing, head shaking, or nodding
- Lack of understanding of social cues
- Inability to engage in simple social games such as peek-a-boo
- Avoids eye contact
- Prefers to be alone or plays parallel to other children
- Lack of pretend or symbolic play
- Deficit in the development of shared attention
- Uses toys in odd ways such as spinning or lining up
- Repetitive body movements such as rocking, pacing, or hand flapping
- Resists changes in routine
- Over- and under-sensitivity to sound, smell, touch, or visual stimulus.

ABA (Applied Behavioral Analysis)

It's difficult to put the pieces together by yourself. But, you're not alone!

Children's Developmental Center offer a program to assist children between the ages of 2-6 years who have received a medical diagnosed of autism.

ABA is the science of changing socially significant behavior. Therapy focuses on identifying the function of a behavior, combined with examining the environment to develop a plan for behavior modification.

ABA Therapy has become widely accepted as one of THE most effective treatments for behavior change. Therapy focuses on what is observable and measurable. Precise and frequent data collection drives the course of treatment.

What is Autism?

Autism, or autism spectrum disorder, refers to a range of conditions characterized by challenges with social skills, repetitive behaviors, speech and nonverbal communication, as well as by unique strengths and differences. We now know that there is not one autism but many types, caused by different combinations of genetic and environmental influences.



Autism is UNIQUE.

Referrals

We work with most insurance companies to provide ABA Services. Requirements vary, so please contact your health insurer. However, most require the individual have:

- a medical diagnosis of Autism or an Autism Spectrum Disorder

Following the evaluation, a personalized treatment plan will be created. This plan will be the working document for the therapists and used to benchmark and quantify progress made by the child.
